

Konstantinos Zervas

Konstantinos Zervas is a graduate of the Experimental School of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, the Department of Civil Engineering at Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, and holds a Master's degree with distinction from Brown University (USA).

In 1990, he established his private office in Thessaloniki. He supervised major projects, served as a Board Member of Attiko Metro S.A. (2010-2016), and as Chairman of the Board of the Thessaloniki State Orchestra (2011-2014). In 2013, he was elected a member of the Central Representation of the Technical Chamber of Greece and the Regional Department of Central Macedonia.

He is the Head of KEDE's Delegation to the Council of European Municipalities and Regions (CEMR), Vice President of the Solid Waste Management Organization (Fo.D.S.A.), President of the Board of the Thessaloniki Municipal Nursery "Agios Stylianos", and a Board Member of Thessaloniki Urban Transport Organization (OASTH).

Elected as a Municipal Councilor of Thessaloniki in 2010, he served as Deputy Mayor for Environment, Quality of Life, and Public Spaces (2011), Permanent Deputy Mayor (2013), and Deputy Mayor for Citizen Engagement, Youth, and Sports (2014). From 2019 to 2024, he served as Mayor of Thessaloniki.

Currently, he is the Chairman of the Water Management and Circular Economy Committee of the Central Union of Greek Municipalities (KEDE).

He is also the author of the book *"Leukes or Chamaerops? Thoughts on Thessaloniki and Politics"* (2019).
