Born in 1976, Kostas Gioutikas comes from Halastra, where he lives with his wife Antonela Dalakoura, a pharmacist, and their two children. His late father, Nikos Gioutikas, served as Mayor of Axios and later Mayor of Delta, while his mother, Mersini Kouimtzi, was a dentist.

He is a graduate of the American College Anatolia and holds a degree in Civil Engineering from Democritus University of Thrace. He is fluent in English and French. He served in the Greek Air Force as a Sergeant.

Since 2001, he has been a member of the Technical Chamber of Greece (TEE) and is a co-owner of a private Technical Design & Construction Company based in Halastra, Delta Municipality.

He has been actively involved in local governance, serving as a Board Member of the Management Authority of Volvi & Koroneia Lakes and Secretary of the Management Body of Protected Areas of Thermaikos Gulf (Axios – Loudias – Aliakmonas National Park).

In 2014, he ran for Regional Councilor of Central Macedonia under Apostolos Tzitzikostas and was elected third in votes among his party's candidates.

In 2016, he was appointed Deputy Regional Governor for Development & Environment, a position he held until April 2024, when he became Deputy Regional Governor of Thessaloniki. In December 2024, he was appointed Deputy Governor of Central Macedonia by Athena Aidona.
