Short Curriculum Vitae of Nicolas Moussiopoulos, Prof. Dr.-Ing. habil., Prof. h.c.

Nicolas Moussiopoulos is a Honorary Professor at the School of Mechanical Engineering of KIT, the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (formerly the University of Karlsruhe). In the period 1989-2023, he served as a Full Professor at the School of Mechanical Engineering, Aristotle University Thessaloniki (AUTh). His research addresses several issues in the broad field of energy and the environment. According to ScholarGPS, 2024 he ranked among the 0.5% top scholars in the broad field of Civil and Environmental Engineering, being among the 0.07% highest ranking scholars working on urban studies.

Among other leading academic positions, Moussiopoulos was the Dean of AUTh's Faculty of Engineering (2006-2010) and Vice-President of the International Hellenic University (2010-2016). He has received various distinctions and awards, among others the Heinrich Hertz Award (1990), the Excellence Award of AUTh (2008), KIT's Medal of Merit (2024) and the Cross of Merit of the Federal Republic of Germany. Since 2002 he has been a full member of the German National Academy of Sciences Leopoldina.
